The Addams Family -The Musical

That lovable family of creepy kooks is alive and well and living in their super-spooky mansion in Central Park. The Addams family, led by the elegantly gaunt and seemingly undead Morticia and her ever-devoted husband Gomez, is in turmoil. Their daughter Wednesday finds herself falling in love — a sensation that is unsettling for both her and her family of endearing misfits. When she invites her new boyfriend, with his "normal" family, over to get better acquainted with the Addams household, comic chaos ensues.

How to prepare for the Auditions

This is a musical, there are no non-singing or non-dancing roles, **everyone** must sing and dance. Please prepare a **short** song, 16 measures is plenty. Do not choose a song from the show. An accompanist will be provided along with a CD player for those who wish to sing with a CD.

You will be asked to learn a short dance routine, so please wear appropriate clothes and shoes. Flip-flops are not advised.

For those interested in a lead role, you will be asked to read from the script. Please refer to the character breakdown for information on those roles.

The Addams Family Character Breakdowns

GOMEZ ADDAMS: A man of Spanish descent who takes great pride in his family. He struggles with having to keep his daughter's secret from his wife, whom he adores more than death. Comedic actor with tenor vocals.

MORTICIA ADDAMS: A woman, in shape, attractive, the strength of the family. Feels her husband is hiding something and will use any tactic to lure the secret out. A comedic actress with a sexy, dry wit. Alto/mezzo soprano vocals.

UNCLE FESTER: Male or female actor. The androgynous family member who serves as the musicals narrator. Larger than life, an energetic, joyous, child-like presence. A vaudeville style comedian with tenor vocals.

WEDNESDAY ADDAMS: An attractive, in shape, girl who has the same dry wit and sensibility of her mother. Finds love with a "normal" boy (Lucas) and wants to introduce his family to hers. Strong vocals.

GRANDMA: A feisty 102 year old woman. Fun and quirky, but don't mess with Grandma. Comedic actress with strong vocals.

PUGSLEY ADDAMS: A charming, funny, husky boy who plays 12 years old. He loves being tortured by his sister. He wants to ensure he won't lose his sister to her new boyfriend. Strong, high vocals.

LURCH: A very tall male character, the Addams butler who knows all. He speaks in moans and groans without becoming a cartoon version of himself. His movement is always very slow. Character actor with a low bass vocals to Eb. MAL BEINEKE: Stuffy father of Lucas and exasperated husband to his rhyming wife. At one time was a follower of The Grateful Dead but has lost that side of himself. High baritone/ tenor.

ALICE BEINEKE: Mother of Lucas, devoted to her family so she puts aside her own desires. A quirky female who often speaks in rhyme. Comedic actress with soprano / belt vocals.

LUCAS BEINEKE: An attractive young man. Fell in love with Wednesday and plans to marry her. Experiences the drama of young love and struggles with the differences between his family and the Addams family. Contemporary pop tenor vocals.

THE ANCESTORS: Male and female ensemble singers/dancers who are smart performers. Sing and dance and have a fun, quirky sensibility. Vocals include Soprano, Mezzo Soprano, Alto, Tenor, Bass.


