Director's Message

Dramatists Play Service, the company that holds the performance rights for "The Dining Room," describes the play as a "mosaic" of scenes about family life and interaction as influenced by accepted norms of behavior in a formal dining room. I was intrigued by the idea that a play could be a mosaic. A dictionary will tell you that a mosaic is "a picture or decoration made of small, unusually colored pieces..." That definition works well when describing fabric or textiles, but how could it relate to a play about human conflict? The answer to that is what makes "The Dining Room" such a unique piece of theatre. If you study a mosaic, you may find yourself drawn to one particular piece of it but because of how it is constructed, you can't ignore the fact that a single piece is surrounded by a number of other pieces. In this production, instead of following a single story from beginning to end, each of the eighteen scenes is a piece of a different story. Before one story concludes, another might begin. Sometimes, then, there are two stories going on at the same time. Much like a multi-faceted mosaic, one can focus on a single piece for only so long without the eye being drawn to the pieces around it.

"The Dining Room" skillfully exposes varying cultural values, but at times challenges them. I've known families that did not come to the dining room unless they were fully and properly dressed, that would avoid "scandalous" topics, and that would pretend that all was well when it wasn't always so. I've known members of those same families who challenge those norms. "The Dining Room" forces us to deal with that, but with a light hand, and sometimes even humor. While personal conflicts are addressed, they are not always fully resolved-as is often the case in our every-day lives. That is another element that makes the play unique. It reminds us that not all stories have a simple, "happily ever after" ending. One of the most interesting truths the play reveals is that there are moments in our lives that are uncertain.

This production of "The Dining Room" is a true example of the "It takes a village" mentality. The 8 actors in the cast play nearly 60 characters. In one scene they may be precocious children, in the next they may be adults worrying about their elderly parents. They will give you scenes that make you smile, chuckle or get tearyeyed. The actors in this cast have worked tirelessly and I am forever grateful to have had the pleasure of working with them. While the actors get take a bow, there are unsung heroes that deserve one as well. Melissa, Cass, Sharon, Gary, Kenny, Debby, Kel, Cheryl, Jodi, Britni, Pete, and Abby — thanks for running my village, even when I might at times have been the village idiot. There are most likely others who are deserving, my apologies if I left anyone out.

Finally, I am grateful for the audiences who come and support the Community Players of Salisbury. Your on-going support provides a wonderful opportunity for us to flex our creative muscles. Thank you so much!

Synopsis

The play is set in the dining room of a typical well-to-do household, the place where the family assembled daily for breakfast and dinner and for any and all special occasions. The action is comprised of a mosaic of interrelated scenes — some funny, some touching, some rueful — which, taken together, create an in-depth portrait of a vanishing species: the upper-middle-class. The actors change roles, personalities and ages with virtuoso skill as they portray a wide variety of characters, from little boys to stern grandfathers, and from giggling teenage girls to Irish housemaids.
