### **Community Players of Salisbury Scholarship**

The Community Players of Salisbury, Inc. is one of the oldest continuously operating community theaters in Maryland. In 1937 a group of 26 charter members hoped to bring culture and pure enter-

tainment to the Eastern Shore while providing an outlet for people interested in dramatics. Community Players was organized in May of 1938.

Community Players will award \$500 to two high school seniors from Somerset, Worcester, Wicomico County and/or Delmar area public, private or homeschooled programs.

Students wishing to apply for this scholarship must:

A. Be a current high school senior in a Somerset, Worcester, Wicomico County or Delmar public, private or home school program.

B. Have applied for admission to a post-secondary institution.

C. Plan to study in any area of theater production, performance or technical support.

D. Have participated in Community Players productions or be a member of a family that has participated in Community Players of Salisbury productions.

E. Have financial need as evidenced by the FAFSA.

The award shall be made under the following specific conditions:

1. Each candidate must submit a completed Community Players of Salisbury scholarship application (available on our website).



2. The scholarship shall be paid directly to the student and shall be used for payment of normal school expenses such as tuition, school fees, room, board or books.

3. Student or their family must have participated in Community Players of Salisbury productions.

4. Final selection of the scholarship recipient will be made by the Board of Directors of the Community Players of Salisbury.

5. Winner will be announced during the student's senior award program or at a Community Players of Salisbury meeting.
