Tony Broadbent was very generous in not charging Players for the use of his lighting equipment. Special thanks to Stevie Stevenson for the use of his trailer at no charge. Thanks also to all of the Board members. Each one pitched in by working where ever they were needed; directing, box office, acting, set construction, parking lot attendant or cleaning the restrooms (yeah, we do it ourselves). Whatever was needed, they were there.



Matt has been a member of Players for the last 8 years, having been a board member twice as well as Corresponding Secretary. Matt's first show with the Community Players was Les Misérables and he has been a part of over 20 shows since then. He also directed Players' production of The Last Five Years in 2019 and was supposed to direct Cabaret in the fall of this year which was unfortunately postponed indefinitely due to Covid-19.

On stage Matt has appeared in many shows. Among his favorites have been *The Addams Family* (Lucas Beineke), *Into the Woods* (Cinderella's Prince), *Moon Over Buffalo* (Paul), *Brighton Beach Memoirs* (Eugene) and *The Foreigner* (Ellard). He most recently was seen on the lawn with Players productions of *Hate Mail* and Film to Broadway.

Matt got his start in theater in his junior year production of *Back to The 80's: The Totally Awesome Musical!* where he played the lead role, Corey Palmer. Since that first show, Matt has not stopped wanting to be on stage or directing.

Samuel "Sammy" Barnes first joined CPOS in the 2008 season playing the role of Officer Penn in the production of *Wait Until Dark* and then his first musical role as the Warden in the 2009 production of *All Shook Up*.

From that point on, Sammy has played an active role in as many productions possible, either as an aspiring actor or assisting with construction, stage crew, lighting assistant, props, costuming, wherever he is most needed.

Sammy has enjoyed playing many roles in various shows either with CPOS or Ocean Pines Players. He has appeared in Dearly Departed, Opal's Husband, Romantic Comedy, Sunshine Boys, Fiddler on the Roof, Rumors, Death Trap, and many more. He also has dabbled in a few movies and television commercials, including the fabulous role of "Greasy Joe" in The Lumberjack of All Trades.
