Synopsis

The three Magrath sisters have gathered to await news of the family patriarch, Old Granddaddy, who is in the local hospital. Lenny, the oldest sister, is unmarried and has stayed to take on the role of caretaker. Meg, the middle sister, quickly left home to pursue stardom as a singer in Los Angeles, but has, so far, only found unhappiness. Babe, the youngest, is out on bail after having shot her husband in the stomach. Their troubles, grave and yet, somehow, hilarious are continuously brought to their attention by their decorous cousin Chick. As the sisters spend more time together, past resentments bubble to the surface. Each sister must come to terms with their shared past and actions as they try to seize the future.

Setting

The entire play takes place in the kitchen of the Magrath family home in the small town of Hazlehurst, Mississippi in 1974, five years after Hurricane Camille (one of just four Category 5 hurricanes to make landfall in the U.S.)






